Any alterations to entries (ie change of rider/class/day/horse £10 per change)

## CROSS COUNTRY

**Pre Intro-** 2'3" max. No ditches, trot through the water. Suitable for first time XC.

**Intro-** 2'9" max

**Pre-Novice-** 3'3" max

As always, Aston le Walls will do everything possible to ensure good going.

## ELIGIBILITY

There is no restriction on BE points in any class. See 'Special Rules' for Intro Championship rules

## STABLING

**On site** stabling on straw is available at £30 per night. **Off site** stabling on straw is available at £20 per night. ## RULES

Horses/Ponies must be 4years of age or older

Riders must be 10 yrs of age or older for PN and Intro. There is no age limit for Pre-Intro

Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted PAS015/BSEN 1284 for jumping phases

Body Protectors and medical arm bands must be worn for the cross country phase

Any horse or pony, which is considered to be unsound, unfit or unhealthy by a Judge or the Organiser will be excluded from further competition without refund of entry fee.

ATV's and motor bikes are not permitted.

The competition will be run in conjunction with British Eventing rules

Start fees to be paid in **cash** at the time of number collection

## COURSE WALK

The Cross Country Course will be available for walking on Friday Apr 16th from noon.

## OBJECTIONS

Objections must be made in writing within half an hour of the incident together with a £50 deposit. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

## SPECIAL NOTES

In case of abandonment please call 07875 732 816

In the very unlikely event of abandonment, any classes not already run will be postponed to 1 week later (24-25<sup>th</sup> April).

Any competitors unable to make this date should state so on their entry form and will be transferred to a later Aston-le-Walls unaffiliated event of the competitors' choice (May 31, Aug15, Sept 19). **There will be no refund of entry fees.**

We would like to reassure competitors that as we have hardcore roads throughout the farm the likelihood of postponement is very small

**High numbers of entries are expected and competitors who are able to provide a helper will be given priority**

Washbrook Farm is home to a shooting enterprise therefore dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.

**Paper numbers will be used, so please make sure that you have a bib (A limited number will be available for purchase at the Secretary's tent on the day)**

**Medical arm bands must be worn for cross country**

**Some Sunday sections may do day before dressage. Please state if you are unable to do this.**

Horse or Rider substitutions will be accepted at the cost of £10, horse and rider substitutions will NOT be accepted unless owned by the same person

- 1) The first SIX ELIGIBLE (see below) combinations in each Intro class held at the March, April, May and August Aston-le-Walls Unaffiliated Horse Trials qualify to enter the Harley Equestrian Intro Championships to be held over the weekend 18-19 September 2010
- 2) **All entries must be made under the horse's passport name. Passports must be provided at the Secretary's at time of number collection at the Championships**
- 3) All combinations must be eligible for BE Intro classes at time of qualifying (i.e. Horse has 0 BE points and rider has not ridden at BE Advanced level in the current or preceding 2 seasons). **COMPETITORS MUST STATE ELIGIBILITY FOR THE HARLEY EQUESTRIAN INTRO CHAMPIONSHIP ON THEIR ENTRY FORM**
- 4) In the event of a non-eligible combination receiving a 1st-6th place, qualification will pass down the line
- 5) In the event of a combination who have already qualified being placed 1st-6th on another occasion, qualification will NOT pass down the line
- 6) Horse substitutions between the qualifier and championship are NOT allowed
- 7) Rider substitutions between the qualifier and championship MAY be allowed, on application to the organiser, provided the substituting rider is of a similar level to the qualifying rider
- 8) The Championships will be held over the weekend of 18-19 Sept 2010. **MOST DRESSAGE WILL TAKE PLACE ON SATURDAY 18th SEPT.** Competitors will run XC on Sunday morning, followed by SJ in REVERSE ORDER on Sunday afternoon, followed by a mounted prizegiving
- 9) Competitors not present at the prizegiving will FORFEIT any prize they may have been entitled to receive.
- 10) The Championships Dressage Test is BE Intro Championship Dressage Test. XC and SJ will be built at maximum dimensions for BE Intro courses and the Championship Intro XC course will include an extra loop.

### CHILTERN&THAMES RIDER MAGAZINE ODE QUALIFIERS

Some classes will count as qualifiers for the CT Rider ODE points Championship (At 2'3, 2'6 and 3'3 levels). All combinations must be registered with CT Rider before the day of the event.
